

NCC SPORT REGULATIONS, ARTICLE 22

# **WRESTLING**

---

(New provisions for 2007-2008 in **bold**)

## **22.1 PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENT**

- (a) Wrestling is an official sport of the North Central Conference, and all member institutions that sponsor a wrestling team shall participate in the conference championships unless excused by official conference action.

## **22.2 SCHEDULE**

- (a) The NCC regular-season schedule shall be single round-robin dual matches scheduled by the institutions with dates and sites are to be arranged by mutual agreement. Home and away sites will rotate each year. Scheduling of the conference dual matches should be done as early as possible before the upcoming season. Each home coach shall inform each visiting coach, at least one (1) month in advance of the match, who the home coach plans to have officiate the match. The visiting coach then must reply immediately whether or not the planned official is acceptable. If the visiting coach does not accept the official, then the home coach must find another official who is mutually agreeable.
- (b) The NCC Wrestling Champion shall be the team(s) on top of the conference standings at the conclusion of the conference single round-robin dual matches.
- (c) All NCC dual meets shall follow weigh-in rules as written in the current NCAA Wrestling Rules and Interpretations.
- (d) The conference office will attempt to post on the conference internet web-site any Conference institution wrestling results that it receives from the institutions so that coaches may review the results prior to the seeding meeting at the NCC Championships.

## **22.3 POST-SEASON COMPETITION**

- (a) Member institutions may enter individuals or teams in the NCAA Division II Championships as qualified.
- (b) An individuals will be responsible for coordinating NCAA selection and regional ranking information.

## **22.4 OFFICIALS**

- (a) Employees or students of member institutions may not serve as officials for matches between member institutions.
- (b) Alumni of member institutions may serve as officials for Conference matches.

**22.6 COACHES MEETING**

- (a) Coaches will meet by conference call on the last Monday of October at 10:00 A.M. Central time (i.e., Monday, October 29, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. Central).
