

Proposals 2007 NCC Spring Meetings

WOMEN'S

Volleyball, Women's Basketball – No Action Items

Passed

Proposal No. 1 – Soccer

Use the point system (3 points for win, 1 point for tie, 0 points for loss) to determine qualifier first, head-to-head second, record against next highest team third, goal differential between two tied teams fourth, coin flip fifth.

Passed

Proposal No. 2 - Softball

Amend 25.8d: "For all conference regular-season and post season tournament games: games will not be played if at the start of the game the wind chill is 32 F or lower or the temperature is below 40 F, unless both coaches agree to go ahead. Once the game has started, the umpire-in-chief will be the sole judge as to the suspension, resumption, or termination of play.

Proposal No. 3 - Softball

Use 3 umpires for all NCC doubleheaders. If doubleheader is rescheduled and three umpires are not available then play can happen with two officials.

Proposal No. 4 - Softball

The high seed is the home team for tournament games 1-4, remaining games the home team will be determined by a coin flip with the higher seed calling the toss. Home team bats last and occupies the third-base dugout.

Men's

No Men's Basketball, Football or Wrestling Action Items.

Passed

Proposal No. 5 – Baseball

When all involved institutions mutually agree to change the site(s) of games, the home team(s) shall provide the visiting team(s): (1) On travel-only days: a minimum of \$8.00 per day meal money for at least **24** players and 5 others; or, on game-days: a minimum of \$10.00 per day meal money for at least **24** players and 5 others.(2) A maximum of **9** motel rooms.

Proposal No. 6 – Track and Field

Indoor and Outdoor Entries be due for each institution by 7:00 PM the Tuesday before the meet as long as an outside timing company is used (i.e. PT timing).

Proposal No. 7 - Golf

Bylaw 28.10. – strike team out of Bylaw and replace with individual “ The type of golf ball to be used shall be determined by the *individual* and must be acceptable under USGA rules.”

Proposal No. 8 - Men’s and Women’s Swimming

To amend the event format to maintain the traditional 4-event individual entry limit. This change was necessary due to NCAA rule changes. (UNO, USD).

Withdrawn

Proposal No. 9 - Men’s and Women’s Swimming

To go with the NCAA 4-day event schedule in order to maintain 4-event individual entry format.

Proposal No. 10 - Men’s and Women’s Swimming

The NCC office sends fourth a proposal to NCAA asking for 4-day modified schedule and find out what events would be necessary to make it 4-day modified meet based on proposal submitted by SCSU. Go by what NCAA says.

Proposal No. 11 - Men’s and Women’s Swimming

If remain same format do appropriate diving prelims before 1000 freestyle and diving finals after 1000 freestyle on day 1.

Proposal No. 12 - Men’s and Women’s Swimming

That the NCC championships be held Thursday-Sunday if the meet moves to full four-day meet.

Proposal No. 13 - Men’s and Women’s Swimming

To use relay touch pads at the 2008 NCC championships if financially and technically possible.

Proposal No. 14 – Men’s and Women’s Swimming

Invite Northern State to be an affiliate member of the North Central Conference in the sport of women’s swimming.
