**Proposal No. 16 – Track and Field**

Nominations with a short bio will be sent to conference office by Monday 12:00 noon following the conference meet. A ballot will be prepared and sent to the coaches with coaches votes due back in the office by 5:00 pm Tuesday. Nominations are based strictly on the conference meet not the entire season. You may nominate the same person for both awards. It was also decided that the release will include only the winners not the nominations.

Wednesday diving prelims shall be held at 3 p.m. with the 1000 freestyle no earlier than 7 p.m. when the women dive and no earlier than 6 p.m. when men dive, allowing at least one hour for warm-ups. Warm-up pool shall remain open throughout the diving competition.
