Curtis Highlights Academic All-NCC Men's Basketball Team

Sioux Falls, S.D. -- Eleven student-athletes have been selected to the 2005-2006 Academic All-North Central Conference Men's Basketball team by a vote of the league's sports information directors. Highlighting the team is Ryan Curtis of Nebraska-Omaha, the only three-time selection on the squad.

Nick Olson of Augustana and Turner Trofholz of South Dakota are the only other repeat honorees on the team, with each student-athlete appearing for the second time.
